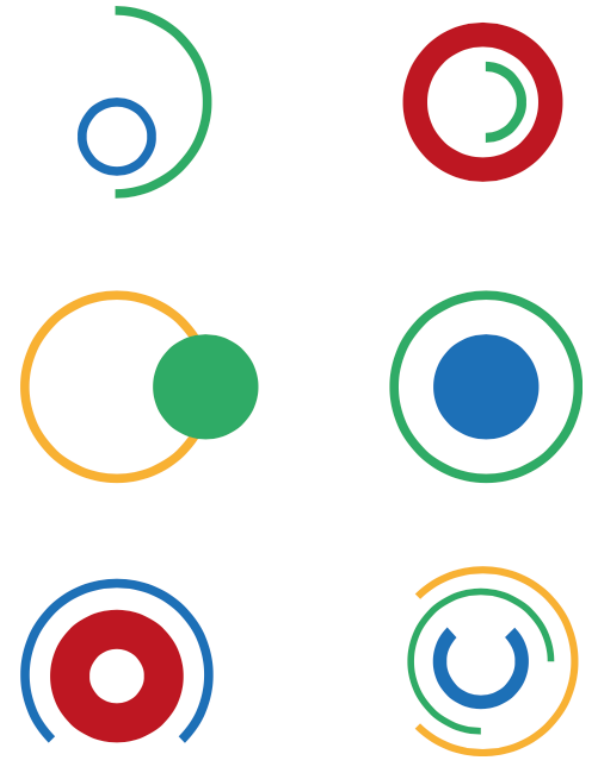

Creating solutions that will not just survive contact with human decision making and organisational environments - but fully leverage their power.
- **Applied acceleration** - 7 weeks of intensive weekly online sessions and 2-day in-person workshops in Cambridge, UK, where we will collectively iterate, shape and elevate your solution, launching you with a fully-formed plan out of the Accelerator.

# Curiosity Incubator | Accelerator for Good phases and modules



## **Phase 1: Incubate:** 4x weekly online sessions, from Feb 2026

- For Good-focused innovation and design: elevating your ideas for more effective solutions
- Behavioural science 1: how people work
- Behavioural science 2: why they do what they do
- Applied systems innovation: who and what do we need on board, and how?

## **Phase 2: Collectively iterate:** in-person 2 days in Cambridge UK, March 23<sup>rd</sup>/24<sup>th</sup> 2026

- Place-led approaches to solutions (municipal Places, organisational places, built environments) – with Cambridge City Council, Open Society Foundations, Cambridge-as-Incubator teams
- How to build cross-society solutions for Good – with UK Govt colleagues, Brazilian Government, Barbados Govt, Australian NSG
- Scarcity, collaboration and resources: how do we craft solutions in challenging times?

## **Phase 3: Accelerate:** 3x online weekly sessions, end March into April 2026

- Frugal innovation/Frugal AI project at Cambridge University – does your solution need “AI” and if so, what and how?
- Futures, foresight and data For Good – with European Commission expertise
- Human-centric solutions testing
- Launching through the concrete wall – launching your solution and making it thrive

# Previous participants' experience



From improving mental health treatments in the UK's National Health System (NHS) to increasing talent retention in the public sector, problems that initially sounded far from each other quickly transformed into a single network of connected statements.

And whenever we think about complex problems like climate change, energy affordability, universal healthcare, or gender inequality, the reality is that the chance of finding solutions to them without combining multi-disciplinary lenses is extremely low. But more important, rather than transferring the impossibility of finding a solution to external barriers, we had the opportunity to continuously think of what we could do to trigger the first quick win towards fixing these complex challenges.

Cohort maximum 22 participants

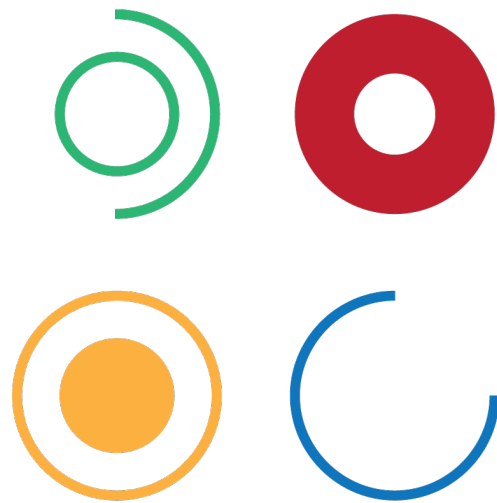
